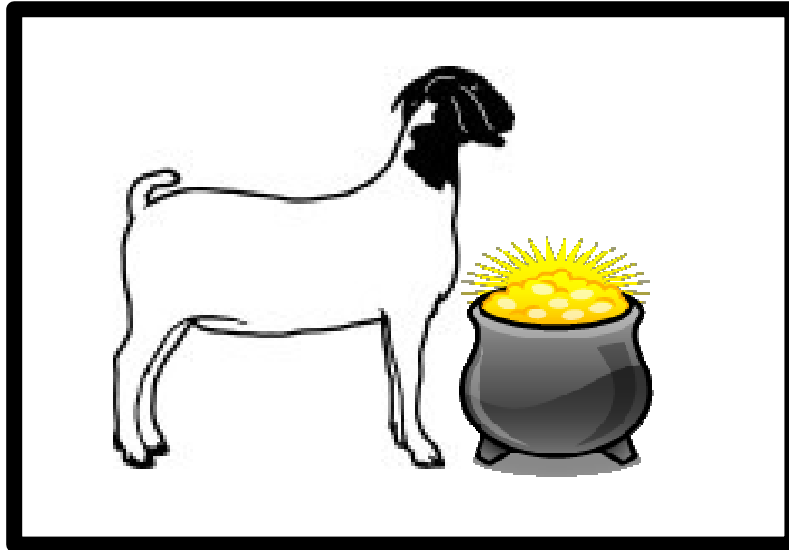

In order to receive points & awards for the MBGA Youth Challenge, youth must be a member of the MBGA, INC. at www.michiganboergoat.org. At this show the youth can participate to earn points with their "market animal" and with "showmanship" towards the MBGA Youth Challenge.

The South Central Jackpot will also be giving out awards for the event.

South Central Jackpot Rules

Michigan Youth Showmanship and Market goat Show

- Open to Michigan youth ages 7-21 as of January 1st 2017 of the show year. Showmanship Divisions will be as follows: Pee Wee (up to 6 years), Novice (7-10 years), Intermediate (11-14 years), Junior (15-17 years), Senior (18-21 years) Youth Market Show (7-21 years). No limit to the number of market animals.
- All youths must be able to handle and show their animal in the show ring, we will have ring stewards for safety of the youth. No parents allowed in the ring, with exception to the Pee Wee, parents are encouraged to walk with youth.
- All animals must be free of sickness, disease, parasites, and any signs of these you will be asked to leave the premises immediately.
- You are responsible for your own bedding and are asked to use only wood shavings.
- Parents and youth are responsible for their own animals , show tack, possessions, and please be aware that if you have animals that are jumpers, it is your responsibility to be prepared to tie them as needed for safety.
- Any youths that are competing in the MBGA Youth Challenge are responsible to send in appropriate applications to the MBGA, Inc. www.michiganboergoat.org. Youths are not required to participate in this event to participate in the South Central Jackpot show, it is only for those who wish to do so.
- All MBGA Youth Challenge Rules apply.
- Animals may have horns or may be disbudded.
- All animals must meet State and Federal requirements, including Scrapie regulations.
- Sportsman conduct is a requirement, by both youth and parents, any misconduct or un-sportsmanship like manner will be dismissed from event and asked to leave grounds, and will not be allowed to participate in the South Central Jackpot for future shows.
- Correct dress code based on the animal that you are showing.
- Judges decisions are to be final.
- Youth may show any breed of goat in showmanship. Market animals must be shown as posted.
- Youth must have their animals checked and weighed no later than 12:00pm on June 25, 2017
- Registration forms must be postmarked no later than June 9, 2017. **Late Entries \$30.00 per Animal Entered.**
- Late Entries are accepted show day during registration times.
- Indemnification/Hold Harmless agreement/Consent to Publish must be signed by parent and youth to participate. This section is located on the entry form.
